Adults will have a Milestone, Lectio Divina, bake cookies for Soups On Us, and have fellowship time. I hope your family will join us!




## **Church Events**

#### **Devotions**

This year I am looking forward to reading through the Bible with my children. In looking online for a Bible reading plan for kids, I found *Foundations for Kids: A 260-day Bible Reading Plan for Kids.* It's 260 days because it's just five days a week. Somehow they must know that we're not perfect and might not get seven days of reading in each week! I have ordered the book, and I would be happy to share it with you. It uses the acronym H.E.A.R., which stands for Highlight, Explain, Apply, and Respond. Kids will study God's word and memorize a verse, read an explanation of the verses, work an activity to help them apply the Bible truth, and have the opportunity to respond in prayer.

Also, I have been using an app called d365, which has devotionals 365 days a year. There are five sections: pause, listen, think, pray, and go. You can read it and reflect in silence, or you can turn on the music. It just takes a few minutes a day and is a great way to start the day.

Finally, be on the lookout for some Taking Faith Home devotional sheets from Milestones Ministry. These include Bible readings, daily devotions, caring conversations, prayers and blessings, and rituals and traditions that you can do as a family at home each week.
